



# Parts Diagram




# **Install With Deck Plate**



- 1. Assemble deck plate 26 and putty plate 25 to faucet.
- 2. Position faucet on countertop.
- 3. From underneath the countertop, assemble plastic base (?) (NOTE: applicable when the faucet is installed in sink), clamp (2) and locknut (2) and screw (2). Tighten the locknut by hand and secure the screws with screwdriver.
- 4. Connect pull-out hose 1 to quick connect assembly 16.
- CAUTION:Make sure hose is properly engaged and secure in quick connect assembly.
- 5. Fix the weight 24 to the pull-out hose 17.
- 6. Connect supply lines to water supply valve.(supply valves and supply lines are not included, please purchase them in local plumbing shops). CAUTION: DON'T OVER TIGHTEN THE SUPPLY LINES.OTHERWISE IT MIGHT DAMAGE THE WASHERS AND NUTS OF SUPPLY LINES AND CAUSE LEAK.
- 7. Remove spray ① from faucet and flush water through faucet to remove any line trash.
- 8. Replace spray ① and run water through faucet for checking leaks at all connections.

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# **Install Without Deck Plate**



1. Position faucet on countertop.


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- 2. From underneath the countertop, assemble plastic base 2 (NOTE: applicable when the faucet is installed in sink), clamp 2 and locknut 2 and screw 2. Tighten the locknut by hand and secure the screws with screwdriver.
- Connect pull-out hose ① to quick connect assembly <sup>1</sup>/<sub>6</sub>. CAUTION:Make sure hose is properly engaged and secure in quick connect assembly.
- 4. Fix the weight 2 to the pull-out hose 1.
- 5. Connect supply lines to water supply valve. (supply valves and supply lines are not included, please purchase them in local plumbing shops). CAUTION: DON'T OVER TIGHTEN THE SUPPLY LINES.OTHERWISE IT MIGHT DAMAGE THE WASHERS AND NUTS OF SUPPLY LINES AND CAUSE LEAK.
- 6. Remove spray (1) from faucet and flush water through faucet to remove any line trash.
- 7. Replace spray ① and run water through faucet for checking leaks at all connections.

# 3 Configuration A. B. B. C. Warning: The supply valves and supply lines are not included.

Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8 " O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8 " Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (1/2  $^{\prime\prime}$  )



### Important:

Tighten connection with two wrench to prevent damage to tube body. Be careful not to bend the stem as this will void the product warranty.

### Important:

Remove the Sprayer and let both hot and cold water run for one minute. To clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble Sprayer.
