Proof of purchase from the original consumer purchaser must be made available for all warranty claims.

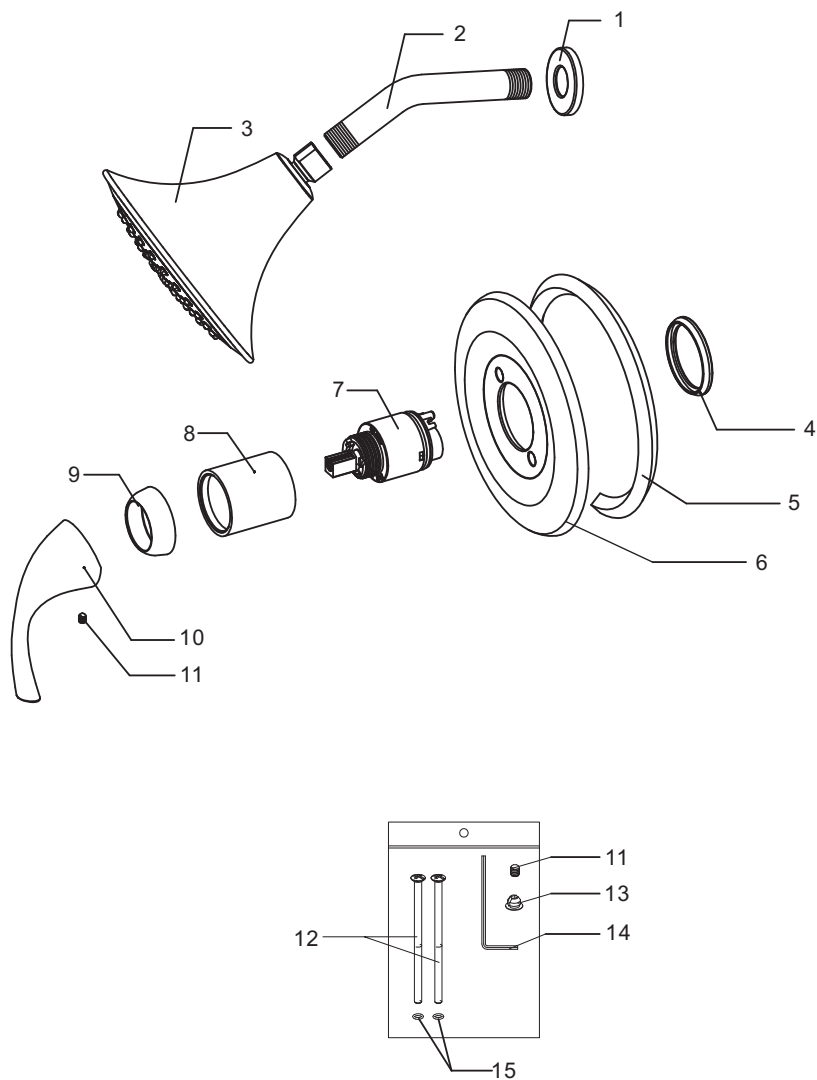

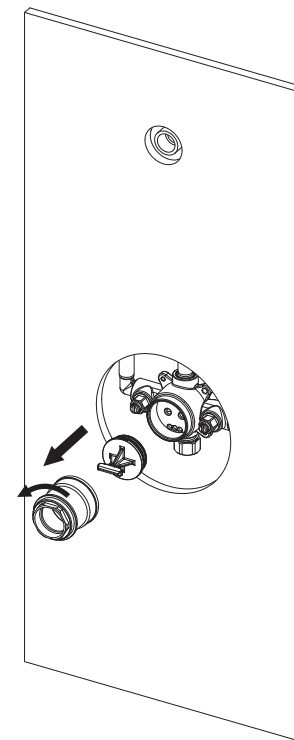
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Parts Diagram

Faucet Installation

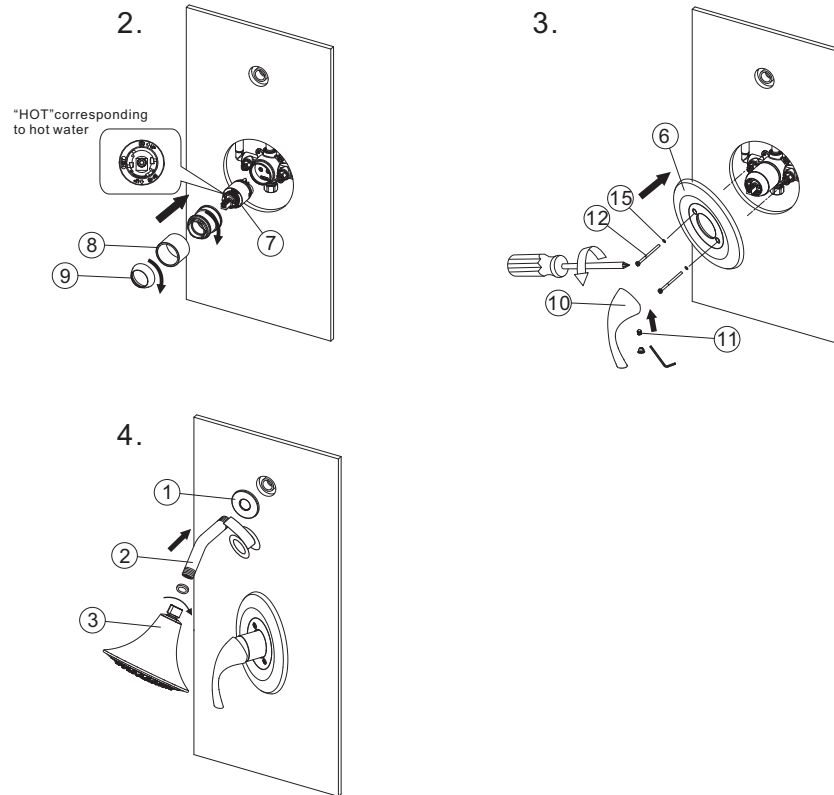

1. Remove the locknut sleeve, O-ring and test plug as shown.
Note: DO NOT DISCARD locknut sleeve. This item is used to secure cartridge.

Faucet Installation



2. Install the cartridge (7), cartridge sleeve (8) and cartridge locknut (9) into the valve body.

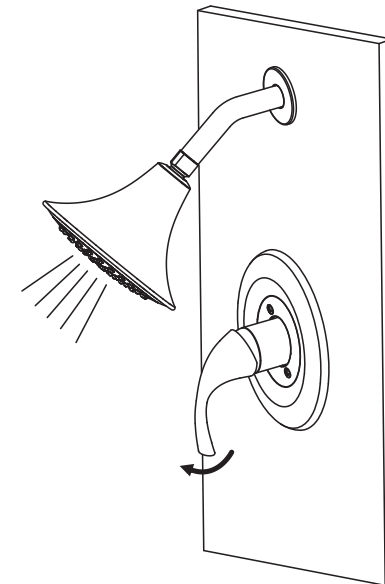
3. Close bathtub drain to avoid losing parts. Install escutcheon (6) and secure it with escutcheon screws (12) and escutcheon screw o-rings (15). Make sure valve is in off position. Then assemble the handle (10) and secure it with set screw (11).

4. Apply teflon tape to two ends of shower arm (2) and install it to wall with shower arm flange (1). And connect the shower head (3) to shower arm (2).

CAUTIONS: ENSURE THE RUBBER WASHER IS IN POSITION BETWEEN THE SHOWER HEAD AND SHOWER ARM.
